

Learning Styles are important

“Learning preferences are important,” said Jaki Edwards, “they are the key to making learning enjoyable for every student.”

We use three broad categories: visual, audio and kinaesthetic.

“It's important that we ensure that our programs contain elements of each learning style and that we understand each individual's learning style so that, if they are experiencing difficulty grasping a concept, the teacher can re-present it in terms of the student's individual learning style,” Jaki said.

At LiteracyCircle we have gone to great lengths to ensure that our programs do cater for all learning styles and that our teachers are aware of the particular learning styles of the children they teach.

It's just another way we strive for excellence in teaching literacy.

Visual learners

Some people prefer to be shown things, they learn by demonstration and they love graphs, wall charts and anything that is visually appealing. What's more, they are best rewarded by giving them things they can see, such as certificates, trophies and the like. They are great at reading maps but don't give them verbal instructions, especially over the phone.



Audio Learners

Audios like to hear things. They learn by discussion, by talking things through. They want to be sure they understand what to do by talking about it, asking questions and analysing answers. It's the conversation that teaches them and prepares them for action. A great line for them is “...but you said...” and they'll usually be right.

Kinaesthetic Learners

Kinaesthetics are little doers. They are “hands on” people who like to learn by doing. They are good at fixing things and are often restless in a classroom when there isn't enough activity happening.

PHONEMIC AWARENESS: This is the first skill when learning to read and is the ability to hear the little sounds in a spoken word and then join the sounds together to make a word.

ALPHABET MASTERY: The second skill is learning the sound for each letter and how to write the letter.

INTRODUCTORY PHONICS: The final pre-reading skill is reading and spelling simple predictable words, e.g 'cat', 'nest', 'swim', 'frog', and 'sun'.

Children learn to have success when reading and develop enjoyment and confidence.

SHORT VOWELS: The first stage is accurately and fluently blending sounds together (read) focusing on the short vowel sounds with short stories and comprehension.

LONG VOWELS: The second stage is to learn long vowel letter patterns and rules for more advanced reading accuracy and fluency.

DIPHTHONG AND ODD SOUNDS: The final stage to reading mastery and confidence is learning letter patterns for diphthong and odd sounds.

Children learn and improve grammar, punctuation and writing skills.

WRITING: From learning to write complex sentences to learning the structure and format for different text types such as narrative, persuasive and descriptive.

PUNCTUATION: Speech marks, use of comma's, contractions and apostrophes.
